Applying an integrative and interdisciplinary perspective, the workshop will pursue at least two goals that seem particularly important in light of the status quo of research: First, to broaden the social scientific view of narrow concepts like 'violence' and 'aggression'; second, to stimulate current research by including topics and approaches that are often ignored in social science, for example, cinematic, photographic, literary, artistic, and philosophical approaches.

The workshop will have a rather open format that allows for extensive discussion of questions that are important to the invited speakers. They are free to choose which questions they would like to bring to the workshop. Such questions might include:

- **What are phenomena that have so far tended to be overlooked or neglected in the context of violence and aggression?**
- **Which approaches that might help us understand violence and aggression have received little attention so far?**
- **What kind of events should be studied and in what ways?**

The format will also give all participants space to engage in discussion with the speakers.
